Upon payment of the proper fees, the following named Permittee is authorized to photograph commercially in the indicated Florida State Park. This permit is subject to all park rules, policies and regulations, and to the conditions set forth herein and in the guidelines for TV and Motion Picture Filming hereto as Exhibit A.

When used for still photography and commercials this permit is valid only for the regular open hours of the park unless otherwise specified and the after hours fee is paid. The open hours of the park are from 8:00 am until sundown. The open hours photography permit fee is \$30.00 per day, plus all applicable admission fees for all persons in the group. The after hours photography fee is \$60.00 per day, plus all applicable admission fees for all persons in the group. The after hours fee also entitles the Permittee to photography in the park during the open hours of the same day which the after-hours fee has been paid. When used for TV program and Motion Picture filming the fees will be \$300.00 per day for all days with 10 hours or less of filming and \$600.00 per day for all days with over 10 hours of filming. Fees are due and payable in advance at the park. Permittee may elect to pay each day upon entering park.

The exact location within the park for the filming operation shall be mutually satisfactory with the Park Ranger and the permittee. If mutually agreeable terms cannot be reached, the Park Manager may revoke this permit.

The Park Manager at his/her discretion may require the permittee to furnish a guard at the permittee's expense. The person serving as a guard shall be subject to approval by the Park Manager. Further, the permittee shall replace the guard upon request of the Park Manager.

By his/her signature hereon, permittee attests that this filming operation is covered by a current liability insurance policy with a minimum of \$3000,000 combined single limit coverage. Permittee assumes all risks in the operation and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the State of Florida, its officers and employees from every claim, suit, loss, damage or injury arising out of any operations under this permit.

If additional specific terms and conditions are required, they will be stated in a location agreement, and attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit B.
